Sunday, November 4th



Nov. 4th & 11th at 9:10 AM



Just like at home, the sermon always seems to speak to what the people need to hear!! God is working!!

Pray for our Bible studies on Sunday mornings that we continue to learn from God as we read His word together. Pray that the others that come will learn something practical for their lives. Declan, Sylvester, Daniel, Angela, Laura, y Roberto are the regulars who come.

Pray that I can continue to find friendship and people to talk to.

I'm going to start spending an informal amount of time during the week helping people who want to learn English. There's so many in the houses that want to learn, so we're going to meet just to talk and learn.”


