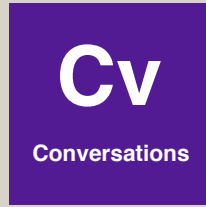

- Everyday life experiences bring plenty of opportunity for spiritual conversations

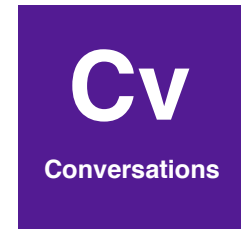
(Decisions, disappointments, friends, enemies, challenges... every experience is worth a Word centered conversation)

Need Someone to Pray with You?

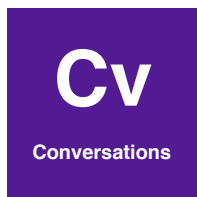
If you would like someone to pray for you or to talk with you about something in your life, our Pastors and Prayer Partners are available in the back of the worship center at the end of each worship service.
