

Prayer Power

I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe. - Ephesians 1:15-19

Paul's passionate prayer came from a heart that could not be imprisoned. He may have been confined by Rome yet; nothing deterred him from praising and praying when he heard of Ephesus' faith in Jesus. He was continuously moved to worship God for them and pray for their kingdom life and work.

Paul prays that they may know God Himself more deeply. He had been with them before, for three years, teaching them. So, he knew that they knew of God but prayed that they would deepen their relationship by knowing Him.

Do you need this today? Do you have knowledge about God but desire to know Him better? Pray this prayer!

Do you know someone who would benefit from knowing God deeply? Have they become distant in their relationship or worse they do not know Him personally? Pray this prayer!

Trust Him

God is ready for a deeper relationship. God is on our side. God is prepared to help. God is always leading the battle against the forces that would keep us from a deeper relationship. God's power is never out of commission.

Paul proclaims the reason for his confident prayer the very power of God in Jesus our Messiah that brings life to that which is dead. Read this!

That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way. - Ephesians 1:19-23
